Welcome to the wonderful world of MACURH! This handbook will assist you in using the MACURH website, utilizing the MACURH list serves, using the NACURH forum, and chatting it up during the MACURH chats.

First up: the MACURH website. The website is your best resource for official MACURH documents, such as the Policy Book (your best friend). This is also where award bids are posted for downloading and printing before conferences. The website is currently housed on a server at the University of Missouri-Rolla.

The website has nine main sections. First: the homepage. This page is where major website updates are listed, MACURH chat and subregional chat times are posted, and basic conference information is posted.

Secondly: About MACURH. This page holds information about the formation and purpose of MACURH.

Third: Official Documents. This page is where you will find all the MACURH documents you could ever want. The Policy book is here, as well as past board meeting minutes, RBD retreat minutes, back issues of the MACURH messenger, conference award bids, bidding guides, and now: MACURH position bids.

Fourth: The Board of Directors Page. The RBD page has...you guessed it, information about the RBD members.

Fifth: MACURH Kudos. This is a new page to the MACURH website, started by past RA-Tech, Natasha Krentz. Just like messenger kudos, this is a place to recognize your fellow MACURH-ites. To list a MACURH kudo, just email the RA-Tech, and they will add your kudo during the next website update.

Sixth: Communication. This page gives you some more information about using the MACURH list serves, the NACURH forum, and MACURH chats. All of these will be covered later. ☺

Seventh: Programming. The programming page explains more about what the RA-Programming does, the MACURH regional philanthropy, the programming grant fund, the responsibilities of programming reps, and minutes from past programming meetings.

Eighth: Conferences. The conferences page has information about each upcoming conference, a link to the conference website, and information on how you can bid for a conference, and who to talk to about bidding for a conference.

And Ninth: MACURH subregions. Each subregion has its own page, which lists the schools in the subregion. In the future, RCCs will have more information about their subregion on each page as well.

After each conference, a page is added to the web page announcing all the award winnings and positions elected.

Next, utilizing the 12 main MACURH list servs!

First off: MACURH-L

Membership to the MACURH-L listserv is open to any person wishing to be on it. If you are on another listserv (such as NRHH), you must be on the MACURH-L list as well. Exceptions may be made for special circumstances and advisors.

The primary usage for this listserv is for general announcements to all of MACURH.

To send email to the MACURH-L listserv, email macurh-l@umr.edu

Second: NCC-L

Membership to the NCC-L listserv is restricted to current NCCs and RBD only. Exceptions may be made for special circumstances and advisors.

The primary usage for this listserv is for discussion and debate between NCCs and announcements that pertain only to NCCs.

Third: NRHH-L

Membership to the NRHH-L listserv is open to all NRHH representatives, NRHH members, and advisors.

The primary usage for this listserv is for discussion and/or debate pertaining to NRHH, announcements that pertain only to NRHH, and any NRHH rep monthly reports.

Fourth: SAT-L

Membership to the SAT-L listserv is open to all Programming representatives and any other person interested in programming.

The primary usage for this listserv is for discussion, debate, and announcements pertaining to programming. This listserv is also used for programming monthly reports.

Fifth: RHPRES-L

Membership to the RHPRES-L listserv is open to RHA presidents and NCCs. Advisors can also join if they would like.

The primary usage for this listserv is for discussion and debate pertaining to RHAs.

Sixth: ADV-L

Membership to the ADV-L listserv is limited to advisors only. There are no exceptions.

This listserv is used as the advisors see fit.

To send email to the ADV-L listserv, advisors should email adv-l@umr.edu

Seventh: IOWA-L

Membership to the IOWA-L listserv is open to Iowa NCCs, NRHH reps, Programming reps, and any person who wishes to be on the listserv.

The primary usage for this listserv is for communication within Iowa and between the Iowa schools.

Eight: KANNEB-L

Membership to the KANNEB-L listserv is open to KanNeb NCCs, NRHH reps, Programming reps, and any person who wishes to be on the listserv.

The primary usage for this listserv is for communication within KanNeb and between the KanNeb schools.

Ninth: MINN-L

Membership to the MINN-L listserv is open to Minnesota NCCs, NRHH reps, Programming reps, and any person who wishes to be on the listserv.

The primary usage for this listserv is for communication within Minnesota and between the Minnesota schools.

Tenth: MISSOU-L

Membership to the MISSOU-L listserv is open to Missouri NCCs, NRHH reps, Programming reps, and any person who wishes to be on the listserv.

The primary usage for this listserv is for communication within Missouri and between the Missouri schools.

Eleventh: SANDM-L

Membership to the SANDM-L listserv is open to SaNDM NCCs, NRHH reps, Programming reps, and any person who wishes to be on the listserv.

The primary usage for this listserv is for communication within SaNDM and between SaNDM schools.

Twelfth: RBD-L

Membership to the RBD-L listserv is limited to current RBD members.

The primary usage for this listserv is for communication between RBD members.

 The NACURH forum is located at <http://www.nacurh.org/forums>. All you need to do is register, and you can post to the forums, which include areas for each region (including MACURH!), general NACURH announcements, and much more!

MACURH Chats are the best way to talk to everyone and get the information you need to know. Chats are held for NCCs, NRHH, and Programming Reps, and each subregion generally has its own chat as well. Because chat times and days may change, they are listed on the MACURH homepage, so you will always have up to date information.

Also available to you is the DTM database at <http://otms.nrhh.org> Here you can find every DTM ever submitted to the database. It's a great way to look for programs for your school, or just to see what is going on all over the country.
