

Spirit Points

Points and submissions will be tracked through the use of the Goosechase app. More Spirit Points may be available on the Goosechase app as the conference progresses. Information for this app is on the next page.

1 point-

- Take a picture of your delegation on the way to the conference

- Send individuals from your delegation to an evening activity (1 point per attendee)

Philanthropy
